





LOCATION AND TRAFFIC NETWORK

The municipality of Laktaši is located in a near vicinity of the border with Croatia and EU, on a very important road connecting Banja Luka with the motorway Zagreb – Belgrade as well as on the motorway connecting Banja Luka – Doboj. The international border crossing of Gradiška, which is a point of inspections for all the types of goods, is 20 km from the municipality centre. Mahovljani Airport presents a link between the Laktaši municipality and a wider region of Europe and the world, while Banja Luka, as an administrative and cultural centre of the Republika Srpska, is only of 20 km distance from Laktaši

WHY SHOULD ONE INVEST IN LAKTAŠI?

In the Laktaši municipality, the number of active companies on 1000 citizens is 15.8, while this number in the RS and BiH is about 9. In 2017, the formal unemployment rate in Laktaši amounted to 18.72%, while it was 31.54% in the Republika Srpska and 33.9% in BiH in the same period.

BUSINESS ZONES

Two industrial zones and two business zones at attractive locations and with constructed business infrastructure for the performance of different production and trade activities are here at the investors' disposal. These are the industrial zones in Veliko Blaško and Laktaši and business zones in Aleksandrovac and Trn. The most important is the business zone in Aleksandrovac where its main purpose is production, but it is also possible to develop trading and service activities.

The current areas intended for investors amount to 28.9 ha and there are still several development area lots free, the size of which vary from 5.000 to 12.000 m².

The land in this zone is owned by the municipality and the price is 6.00 BAM/m². The available infrastructure consists of: asphalt road with lighting going through the middle of the business zone and connecting it with the main road M-16, water supply network, telecommunication network, organised waste disposal and electrical energy supply



A feasibility study was done for the new business zone, i.e. for the Agri-Business Park of 'Aleksandrovac' of 124.3 ha, according to which the investment into this zone is justified and acceptable, as the very investment would have a positive effect onto a wider socio-economic environment.



tourism

The Laktaši municipality owns natural resources and capacities for the development of health and recreational tourism.

- The thermal and mineral water spas of Laktaši and Slatina have several decades of tourist tradition in healing of rheumatic diseases, cardiac diseases, the eyes and blood circulation. They include hotels with swimming pools, medicinal baths and all the necessary activities for medical treatment, which provide the services of health and recreational tourism.
- Out of many archaeological sites, which the turbulent history of this municipality has left as a part of the cultural and historical heritage, worthwhile visiting are the remains of the necropolis of tombstones, the so-called stećci at the sites of 'Osoje' and the 'Log Church' from XVIII century close to Slatina as well as the remains of the former Roman thermal baths at the site of 'Zidine' in Laktaši.
- Development and protection of the archaeological site early Byzantine
 walls of 'Balkis' in the village of Gornji Bakinci, as an interesting
